

Privacy Notice for CUWiP UK at Oxford Physics

In the course of applying, registering and attending CUWiP UK, you have provided information about yourself ('personal data'). We (the University of Oxford) are the 'data controller' for this information, which means we decide how to use it and are responsible for looking after it in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation and associated data protection legislation.

How we use your data

We will use your data to process your application for the Conference for Undergraduate Women in Physics (CUWiP) at the Department of Physics, University of Oxford. Using your data in this way is necessary for a task that we carry out to meet our legitimate interests in supporting the development of scientists that identify as women and showcasing options for their educational and professional futures (i.e. running CUWiP).

We will only use your data for the purposes for which we collected it, unless we reasonably consider that we need to use it for another related reason and that reason is compatible with the original purpose. If we need to use your data for an unrelated purpose, we will seek your consent to use it for that new purpose.

Who has access to your data?

Access to your data within the University will be provided to those who need to view it as part of their work in carrying out the purposes described above.
